

Summer School Catch Up Programme 2021

In light of the Covid-19 pandemic, the DfE allocated funding to be offered to secondary schools running a summer school catch up programme.

At Beauchamps High School, we invited all of our new Y7 pupils to take part in our summer school as part of the transition process. We ran a week-long summer school from 23rd August – 27th August and included a mixture of enrichment and targeted maths and English activities. The sessions were designed to help support students with the transition from primary to secondary but to also identify and begin to close gaps in maths and English.
