Sports Day

This year our annual summer Sports Day will be held on the following days:

Thursday 13 July: Field Events only at Beauchamps High School

- Competitors **must** wear correct PE kit to school
- Students not competing attend normal lessons in school uniform.
- Period 1 Year 7 Field events

- Period 2 Year 9 Field Events
- Period 3 Year 8 Field events
- Period 4 No year groups lessons as normal
- Period 5 Year 10 Field Events

Friday 14 July: Track Events at Bartletts Park (map attached)

- Competitors **must** wear correct PE kit
 - Non-uniform day for non-competitors

On Thursday 13 July, field events will take place during periods 1-5. If your child is competing for their form in a field event, they will need to arrive to school in the correct PE kit ready to participate, although they must bring their school uniform with them in the event that Sports Day is cancelled due to poor weather. Students who are not participating are required to wear school uniform as normal. All students will need to bring their equipment e.g. books to attend normal lessons.

Friday 14 July will be the whole school Sports Day, with track events taking place at Bartletts Park. **All students will be expected to arrive at Bartletts Park at 9.30am for registration** and will be met by staff upon arrival.

Events will take place from 9.45am to 12.30pm, students will then return to school by walking back with form tutors and heads of year. The route will be marshalled by staff to ensure the safety of the students. There will be an extended lunch for all years when they return to school from 12.45pm to 1.45pm. Students will then attend period 5 lessons, with the school day finishing at normal time 2.45pm.

All students, whether competing or not, will be outside to watch the track events, it is therefore advised that students bring sun lotion, a hat and plenty of water to drink. Refreshments will be available to purchase throughout the morning, if your child would like to bring some money.

In the event of poor weather, a decision to cancel Sports Day will be taken early on Friday morning and published on the school website/twitter as well as emailed out to all parents/carers. If cancelled, it will be a normal school day and school uniform must be worn.

Unfortunately, due to the large number of students being seated on the field, we regret that we are unable to invite parents/carers to spectate. We look forward to this event and hope the students find it enjoyable.
