## MATHEMATICS DEPARTMENT

The Mathematics Department has a staff of nine Mathematics specialists and is accommodated in a specialist Mathematics suite of rooms with several well-stocked resource areas. These classrooms are all equipped with a PC with Internet access and interactive whiteboard facilities.

Students are taught in ability sets for Mathematics from Years 8-11 and in tutor groups in Year 7. The Year 7 and 8 schemes of work are based on the new maths curriculum for Key Stage 3.

Students study both Mathematics and Statistics in Year 9 and may be entered for the Edexcel GCSE Statistics exam at the end of Year 10. Students will then go on to study GCSE Mathematics in Year 11. We are committed to helping students reach their potential and offer revision sessions and individual help outside of lesson time. 79% of our Year 11 students were awarded grades A\*- C in GCSE Mathematics in 2015. 90% of our Year 10 students entered for GCSE Statistics were awarded grades A\*- C in 2015.

In Year 12 and 13 students follow the Edexcel modular A level course. We currently offer an AS of C1, C2 and S1, and an A2 of C3, C4 and D1. We are also offering both AS and A2 level courses in Further Mathematics.

Mathematics is a lively, supportive and popular department in which the emphasis is on promoting the student's confidence and enjoyment in addition to their mathematical skill. We run several weekly Maths clubs and after-school revision sessions including one aimed at Sixth Form Mathematics students.

The successful candidate will be capable of effective and enthusiastic teaching across the age and ability range.

The school is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people and expects all staff and volunteers to share this commitment. If successful, an enhanced DBS will be sought.
